Abstracts will be reviewed and selected for either oral or poster presentation. Prizes to the value of £100 and a commemorative certificate will be awarded to the presenters of the best poster and oral presentation, as judged by a review panel on the day.

Authors will not be required to write a formal paper for this conference. All accepted abstracts will be published on the website shortly before the event. The event will be £60 registration fee, but free to attend for students with proof of student status shown on arrival.
